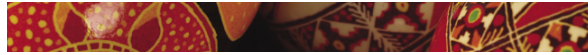

The Sister City concept evolved from President Eisenhower's "People to People" program and is now embodied in Sister Cities International, an organization based in Alexandria, Virginia. Over 900 cities representing millions of Americans have established links with counterparts around the world. Corvallis and the Corvallis Sister Cities Association are members.

Our Mission

The mission of the Corvallis-Uzhgorod Sister Cities Association is the development and enrichment of relationships between the cities and organizations of Corvallis, Oregon, USA and Uzhgorod, Ukraine.

Our Goals

The goals of the C-USCA are to foster understanding and friendships, provide and expand cultural experiences, develop and support citizen leadership, and enhance social and economic conditions for the citizens, families, organizations, businesses, and the governments of the two cities.



What We Do



Our history is rich with successful projects carried out both in Corvallis and in Uzhgorod. Recent activities include:

- The TOUCH project: "Take One Ukrainian Child's Hand" is a sponsorship program for nearly 350 children in need in Uzhgorod.
- Corvallis-Uzhgorod Search and Rescue Alliance, including support for the fire and police departments, is engaged in the exchange of technical expertise, support from the US to Ukraine in the way of equipment and supplies, and aspires to sponsor and exchange of professionals between the two countries.
- Corvallis-Uzhgorod Sister Cities Association has sent five official ATU (Aid to Uzhgorod) shipments since 1994. Together, these shipments have totaled over 200,000 pounds of humanitarian aid.
- Sister Cities Week: Each year, during Sister Cities Week, displays and special programs are featured.
- Flower Basket Fund Raiser: During the weeks preceding Mother's Day each spring, Peoria Gardens provides an array of beautiful hanging flower baskets to C-USCA at cost, which we sell throughout the community.
- Majestic Theatre Fund Raiser: Each winter we sponsor an evening or afternoon of multi-cultural entertainment at the Majestic Theatre in Corvallis.
- Annual Membership Meeting: During June all members are invited to meet, elect new board members, and enjoy an informative program.
